We would like to invite all the knitters of Cotgrave to knit or crochet poppies to help form this display. Poppies must have a safety pin sewn on the back of each poppy.

You can use any pattern you like, but if you do not have a pattern, patterns can be obtained from Cotgrave Town Council Office and Cotgrave Library.

Collection boxes will be placed in the Church, the Library and also in the Council Office (located in the Leisure Centre on Woodview) to put your knitted poppies in.



The display will be put together for the Remembrance Day Service on Sunday 11th November 2018.

Many many poppies will be needed to complete the display, so if you are a knitter can you please help?

After the display, the poppies will be used to help raise funds for the Royal British Legion Poppy Appeal 2019.
