COUNCIL VACANCIES – CO-OPTION

Council would welcome written expressions of interest from anyone in Cotgrave who wishes to join the Council. Cotgrave Town Council has 4 casual vacancies to be filled by co-option, to serve on Council for the next 4 years.

Anyone aged 18 or over and, in addition, meets at least one of the following criteria:-

- be a local government elector of the Parish
- has, during the whole of the 12 months preceding the day on which he/she was nominated as a councillor, occupied as tenant or owner, any land or other premises in the Parish.
- his/her principal or only place of work in the 12 months preceding the day on which he/she is nominated as a councillor has been in the area of the Parish.
- has resided either in the Parish or within three miles thereof during the whole of the 12 months preceding the day on which he/she is nominated as a candidate.

There are certain disqualifications of which the main are:-

- bankruptcy
- having been sentenced to a term of imprisonment of not less than three months during the five year preceding the election
- being disqualified under any enactment to corrupt or illegal practices.

If you express an interest in being co-opted, you will be invited to attend a Cotgrave Town Council Meeting.
