



PLASTIC LIDS AND BOTTLE TOPS

So many people are confused about which bin to put their plastic tops into. **PLEASE DO NOT PUT THEM IN THE BLUE BIN**. In Rushcliffe they need to go in the grey bin then they go to landfill or incineration.

HOWEVER, we have been made aware about a scheme that sends them for recycling to raise funds for Dove Cottage, a Day Hospice in the Vale of Belvoir.

What happens to all the tops? The tops are collected and then taken to a dedicated Dove Cottage volunteer who then washes, bleaches and prepares and takes them to a waste company in Colwick, where they get paid £75 per ton. This amount is then Gift Aided and becomes a £100 which is then donated to the charity.

Cotgrave Town Council are looking for collection points within Cotgrave where residents, business etc can drop off the plastic tops, then once a month these will be collected and taken to the dedicated volunteer to process.
