Who is eligible for the autumn 2025 COVID-19 vaccination programme?

- Older adults: Everyone aged 75 years and over.
- Care home residents: People living in care homes for older adults.
- **Immunocompromised individuals:** Individuals aged 6 months and over who are immunosuppressed (have a weakened immune system).

Who is eligible for the autumn 2025 influenza vaccination programme?

Adults

- Individuals aged 65 and over:
- **Pregnant women**: can receive the vaccine at any stage of their pregnancy.
- People aged 18 to 64 in a clinical risk group, such as those with chronic conditions like asthma, diabetes, heart, kidney, liver, brain or nerve conditions, or a weakened immune system.
- Household contacts of immunocompromised individuals
- Carers: in receipt of carer's allowance or who are the main carer of an older or disabled person.
- Frontline health and social care staff
- Those living in long-stay residential care homes.
